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### Missoula City-County Health Board Accepting Applications for Medical Doctor

The Missoula City-County Board of Health is accepting applications for a medical doctor to serve on the [Health, Air Pollution Control, and Water Quality District Boards](#). Applications must be received no later than 5 p.m. on Monday, May 9, 2016.

Education and experience in public health is desired. Eligible applicants must submit a letter of application, resume, proof of current licensure as a medical doctor in the state of Montana, and a home address (not a post office box) in Missoula County as proof of residence.

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*The Board of Health is the policy-making body that determines the goals, objectives, and programs for the delivery of public health services to Missoula residents, both city and county. The Board has statutory authority and responsibility, including rule-making and adjudication, as well as budgeting authority. The Board is responsible for selecting the Health Officer, who carries out statutory duties and directs the health department.*
