County Commissioners Seeking Applicants for Board Positions

The Missoula County Commissioners are looking to fill vacancies on seven boards. All applications are available [online](#) or in the County Commissioners' Office, located at 199 West Pine Street. Submissions may be filed electronically, emailed to bcc@missoulacounty.us or faxed to (406) 258-3943. Deadline for applications is Friday, June 3, 2016 by 5 p.m.

[Missoula] Aging Services Governing Board: Four three-year terms will expire June 30, 2016; and one term to 2017 will be vacant. Purpose is to develop, implement and monitor strategic plan, providing a comprehensive and coordinated system for the delivery of programs and services that promote the independence, dignity and health of older adults and those who care for them. The Board is seeking candidates who are business-savvy and civically engaged, as well as applicants with Board governance experience in a nonprofit environment.

Lolo Mosquito Control Board: One unexpired term to December 31, 2016 is vacant. Manages and controls mosquitoes while providing for the protection of humans, livestock, pets, songbirds, gamebirds, game animals, and the environment in general.

Missoula Development Authority: Three three-year terms set to expire. Maintains oversight of the development, management and marketing in and for the tax increment districts in Missoula County. One board position must be a member of the Technology District.

Parks & Trails Advisory Board: Two three-year terms set to expire. Monitors and evaluates issues relating to County parks and trails, and reports to the BCC with its recommendations.

Tom Green Memorial Park at Pineview: Five three-year terms expire. Provides advice and makes recommendations to County Parks & Trails Advisory Board for matters involving Tom Green Memorial Park - including expenditures of funds collected through RSID 902.

Weed Control Board: Two alternate positions are vacant. Oversees the planning, implementing and developing of a coordinated program that includes education, prevention, management and research as described in the district's Noxious Weeds Management Plan.

Zoning Board Of Adjustment: One optional alternate position is vacant. Administers provisions of the County Zoning Resolution; hears and decides appeals, variances, and special exceptions to provisions in the Zoning Resolution.
