Missoula County has been awarded the Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting by the [Government Finance Officers Association of the United States and Canada](#) (GFOA) for fiscal year 2015.

This achievement is the highest form of recognition in the area of governmental accounting and financial reporting. Attainment represents a significant accomplishment by a government and its management. Missoula County's Financial Services Director, Christi Page, has been designated as being primarily responsible for preparing the award-winning Consolidated Annual Financial Report (CAFR).

"We are thrilled that the GFOA has singled out Missoula County for our 'excellence in financial reporting,'" Page said. "We pride ourselves on providing accurate, timely financial information to our constituents in an understandable format through our CAFR."

The Award is granted to governments who go beyond minimum reporting requirements and strive to provide transparency and full disclosure of all governmental activities to all interested parties.
