Voter Services Provided at the Elections Center at the Fairgrounds

The Missoula County Elections Office reminds voters that the Elections Center, located at the Missoula County fairgrounds, is the central location for all voter services. The courthouse office is unable to issue ballots to voters or conduct late registration. These are the two of most requested services leading up to Election Day and must be completed at the Elections Center, where the corresponding equipment is housed and where more staff are available to quickly assist voters.

The Missoula County Elections Office is divided between two locations: the courthouse and the fairgrounds. The services at the courthouse include phone support, mail processing and ballot drop off. The Elections Center is open weekdays from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. to assist residents with all of their voting needs.

The Elections Center offers the following services:

- Provide absentee ballots and late registration assistance.
- Offer extended hours from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. weekdays and the two Saturdays before Election Day.
- Issue replacement ballots.
- Offer a 24-7 ballot drop off site.
- Provide an ADA accessible AutoMark voting machine.

The Missoula County Elections Office urges voters to take advantage of extended hours before Election Day to help them avoid any wait times on Nov. 8. The last day to request an absentee ballot is Monday, Nov. 7 by 12 p.m. Same Day voter registration opens on Election Day from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Voters should verify their voter registration information by visiting www.MyVoterPageMT.com to view their registration status, where their polling place location is, sample ballots, and more. Voters who are not registered or need to update their information must appear at the Elections Center at the fairgrounds to register and receive a ballot.

Absentee ballots are due by 8 p.m. on Election Day, Nov. 8. Absentee ballots can be delivered in person to the courthouse or fairgrounds now through Election Day. On Election Day, absentee ballots can be dropped off at any polling place location.
