### Missoula County Commissioners Seeking Applications for Big Sky Park Stewardship Committee

Three positions on the [Big Sky Park Stewardship Committee](#) will become available on March 31. The Board of Missoula County Commissioners is seeking applicants who have a strong interest in the management of the County's Big Sky Park, a 155 acre parcel on Tower and Spurgin Road. Applicants from the Big Sky Park neighborhood are strongly encouraged to apply to ensure their community is well represented in planning efforts.

The committee is comprised of five members of the general public and one representative from each organization who holds a current maintenance and management agreement for use of the park.

Big Sky Stewardship Committee members advise the County Parks & Trails Advisory Board in implementing the Tower Street Park Complex Management and Utilization Plan (Big Sky Park Plan); communicating with the lease/agreement and agreement holders and outreach to neighbors of Big Sky Park; and reviewing proposals related to use and activities at Big Sky Park.
