

Different voter scenarios arise post “close of registration.” Close of registration occurs 30 days prior to Election Day. To ensure you get to the right place fast, follow our Voter Scenarios guide.

Voter Scenarios

Registered

Check [My Voter Page](#) to ensure address & information is correct.

If information is correct and voter does not have Absentee Status, elector may request an absentee ballot by noon the Monday before Election Day or they can go to respective polling place on Election Day. Elector should identify correct polling place via [My Voter Page](#)

Not Registered

Electors must visit the Elections Center at the Fairgrounds for Late Registration and to receive a ballot.

Change of Address within Last Two Years

First, the elector should visit the [My Voter Page](#) to determine if our office has received a “change of address” voter registration card.

If the information is correct, no action is required by the elector.

If the voter finds the information is not correct, the voter has two options:

1) Montana law allows a voter to vote one last time in their old precinct. The voter may go to their previous polling place to cast a ballot on Election Day. At that time, the voter will complete a new voter registration card to update their information.

2) The voter must visit the Elections Center at the Fairgrounds to late register for their new address and receive a ballot for their current precinct.

Absentee Ballot Request

Voters may request a ballot be mailed to them. The voter must submit an [Absentee Request Form](#) in person, by mail, or faxed to our office.

UOCAVA

(Military & Oversea Voters)

Those serving as uniformed service members overseas, or individuals living abroad may continue to vote in US elections. Voters must complete a [Federal Post Card Application](#) to register and receive a ballot.
