Failure to provide this information will result in your application being returned to you.** You must make sure that you have current rabies information to run concurrently with the length of time you are licensing for. Please provide a copy of your current rabies vaccination certificate. You must be 18 years or older to license your dog in Missoula County. The original license tag you receive will be a permanent tag issued for the life of the animal. *Replacement tags are available for \$5.00.* Please call our office @ 541-7387 if you have any questions regarding licensing. **Prorated licensing costs on back of this form.**

## PRO-RATING YOUR DOG LICENSE FEES

Dog licenses can only be issued for the period of time the rabies shot is good for. If there is not a full year left on your rabies vaccination you are not able to purchase a one year dog license. The following is a guide to help you send the correct fees to obtain your dog license.

| <b>If the rabies expires within:</b>               | <b>3 months</b> | <b>6 months</b> | <b>9 months</b> |

| <b>Puppy license<br/>(dog less than 1 yr. old)</b> | <b>\$3.75</b>   | <b>\$7.50</b>   | <b>\$11.25</b>  |
| <b>Spayed/neutered dog</b>                         | <b>\$5.00</b>   | <b>\$10.00</b>  | <b>\$15.00</b>  |
| <b>Unaltered dog</b>                               | <b>\$8.75</b>   | <b>\$17.50</b>  | <b>\$26.25</b>  |
| <b>Senior license (owner 65 yrs. or over)</b>      |                 |                 |                 |

For rabies vaccinations that expire prior to two years, you would add the appropriate one year license fee and then the corresponding prorated fee . Example: a rabies vaccination that has 1.5 yrs. left for a dog that is spayed/neutered, you would send the \$20.00 fee for one year, plus the \$10.00 fee for half of a year. Your license will then expire at the same time the rabies vaccination does. This way the next time your dog gets a rabies vaccination the dog could be licensed for one, two or three years depending on your preference.
