



FLOOD RESOURCE FACT SHEET

HOW TO HELP

Sandbagging. Team Rubicon has completed its volunteer sandbagging operation at Fort Missoula, and approximately 21,000 pre-filled sandbags are still available for property protection and other flood-relief efforts.

Resources donations. The County asks that businesses or individuals looking to donate resources (sand, sandbags, bottled water, etc.) fill out the online form at <http://bit.ly/ResourceDonations>.

Monetary donations. Visit www.MissoulaUnitedWay.org/donate to donate money to the 2018 flood fund, which is currently being used to purchase sand. People can also make monetary donations through the Red Cross at www.redcross.org/Montana, by calling 1-800-272-6668 or mailing a check to 1300 28th St. S., Great Falls, MT 59405. (Note: Red Cross accepts single cases of water and pre-packaged shelf-stable food, but is unable to accept other donations.)
