

CHANGES FOR FY 2019

The following changes are proposed for FY2019 Plan year. An Amendment will be presented to the Board of County Commissioners. The signed amendment will be provided to plan members along with information regarding the changes.

***Alternative Medicine – We have increased the maximum benefit of \$500.00 per benefit year to a maximum benefit of \$750.00 per benefit year. This benefit is subject to your deductible.

***Alternative Medicine – Compound prescriptions may now be submitted for reimbursement under the Alternative Medicine benefit. You must provide proof of payment on an invoice that includes the pharmacy name, contact information, tax i.d and patient information.

***Physical Therapy – Physical therapy services will be limited to 21 visits per benefit year.

***Prescriptions – Effective July 1, 2018, we will be changing our formulary with our pharmacy benefit manager MedImpact and modifying our co-pay and co-insurance for pharmacy benefits as illustrated in the below table.
