Each year since 1993 the Missoula Valley Water Quality District has held a Household Hazardous Waste Collection Event. Many unwanted hazardous and toxic materials are accepted from Missoula County Residents for no charge, including oil-based paints and stains, paint thinner, degreasers, gasoline, other flammable liquids, aerosol paints, fertilizer, non-alkaline household batteries, used motor oil and antifreeze.

CARDBOARD

Corrugated boxes & brown kraft grocery sacks only.

No Beverage:

six/twelve pack containers

No Chipboard:

cereal, shoe, Kleenex boxes

No Tubes:

*Toilet Paper, Paper Towels,
Cores from any other rolled products*

NEWSPAPER

*If it comes in the newspaper,
it is acceptable.*

OFFICE PAPER

Acceptable Office Paper:

*White Paper
Pastel Colors
Manila Folders
Envelopes (window OK)
Most junk mail
Above List Shredded*

Paper clips, staples, tape, rubber bands and sticky notes are OK.

Carbon Paper
Deep Tone or Bright Colors
Construction Paper
Wet Strength Paper
Paper Cups, Napkins
ANYTHING BROWN
Is UNACCEPTABLE

Paper Bags, Cereal Boxes
T.P. Rolls, etc.*

MAGAZINES & CATALOGS

All magazines and catalogs

ALL METAL & STEEL

ALUMINUM CANS

Clean & dry aluminum cans only.

TIN CANS

Rinsed & dry tin cans only.

PAINT

Latex paints - Dry it out using cat litter or other absorbent product and dispose of with your normal trash.

Oil Based paint and stain - Must be disposed of at Haz Waste days.

Please ask attendant for more details.

MISCELLANEOUS

Car batteries - Can be deposited at Napa or Parts Plus in Seeley Lake.

Propane tanks with valves intact - Can be disposed of at Cenex located at 4570 N. Reserve St. in Missoula.

Propane tanks with valves removed - Can be placed in the metal bin.

Used Motor Oil - Clearwater Towing in Seeley Lake may accept used motor oil.
