JOB DESCRIPTION: Under the supervision of a Nurse Manager at the Missoula City-County Health, assist with the investigation and control of a community-wide outbreak of pertussis.

JOB DUTIES:

- Contact parents of children who may have been exposed to pertussis at school.
- Screen students in schools that have had confirmed pertussis cases.
- Record confidential patient, contact, test and treatments results and other investigation actions on department records.
- Answer questions about pertussis, outbreak control activities for parents, schools, and members of the public.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- Proof of current licensure as a Registration Nurse with the Montana State Board of Nursing OR; completion of Nursing Boards and proof of temporary nursing license
- Current Montana Driver's license
- Proof of current MMR, Tdap, Hep B immunizations and Tb test.
- Ability to use e-mail and basic computer software for word processing and web-based data entry and report retrieval.

WORK ENVIRONMENT

- In an office and school setting.
- Drive to schools, daycares, and other facilities in Missoula County.
- Weekdays, evenings, and weekends.
