Missoula County Commissioners to Hold Final Budget Hearing This Week

The Missoula County Commissioners will hold a public hearing on the county's final budget for fiscal year 2020 at 2 p.m. Thursday, Aug. 22, in the Sophie Moiese Room of the Courthouse Annex. Members of the public are encouraged to participate by attending the hearing or watching it online, either live or after the meeting, at <http://missoula.co/bccmeetings>.

The public is encouraged to review the final budget, copies of which will be available at the public hearing and posted online at <http://missoula.co/budgets>.

In addition to attending the public hearing, residents can comment by calling the Commissioners' Office at 406-258-4877, emailing bcc@missoulacounty.us or mailing comments to the Commissioners' Office, 200 W. Broadway St. Missoula, MT 59802.

As the hearing is an opportunity for taxpayers to provide comment, commissioners will not vote on the budget at the Thursday hearing. After considering the additional public comment received, they will vote to adopt the final budget at their administrative public meeting at 10 a.m. Tuesday, Sept. 3, in the Sophie Moiese Room.
