## **Missoula County Commissioners Seek Applicants for the Tax Appeal Board**

Missoula County commissioners are seeking applicants to fill one three-year term on the county Tax Appeal Board that expires March 31. The new three-year term begins April 1 and runs through March 31, 2023.

The board is comprised of five members and meets to hear taxpayers' appeals from property tax assessments and attend meetings called by the state tax appeal board. The county tax appeal board is in session from July 1 until Dec. 31 of the current tax year to hear protests concerning assessments made by the Department of Revenue. The board meets until all protests have been considered, and, as provided in MCA 15-2-201, may meet after Dec. 31. Protests are heard during business hours and require board member participation and dedication during that time. Applicants must be Missoula County residents.
