Understanding Step Therapy

What is a Step Therapy?

A: Step therapy is a type of prior authorization that requires you to try a more cost-effective, safe drug before a more costly or risky drug will be covered. The goal of step therapy is to find the most cost-effective and safe drug for you.

Why do I need Step Therapy?

A: Step therapy minimizes risk and saves you money. Generic medications are medically appropriate and effective, and can significantly reduce costs for both you and your health plan.

How does Step Therapy work?

A: The step therapy program requires you to use “first-line” generic medications before alternative (“second-line”) medications are dispensed. The first-line medication is usually less expensive and has been proven effective for many people being treated for the same condition.

Do I have to do anything?

A: Your pharmacy will automatically check your prescription history to see if you have already tried the first-line medication. If you have, then a second-line prescription can be processed. If the pharmacy system doesn’t find a history with the first-line medication, then you will need a prior authorization.

Understanding Formulary

What is a formulary?

A: The Formulary is a list of covered and preferred drug agents for MedImpact prescription drug plan member. The preferred drug agents will be the least expensive while the non-preferred drug agents will be the most expensive.

When is the formulary updated?

A: The formulary is updated on a quarterly basis. If a change in formulary results in a negative impact to you, a letter will be sent to you outlining the change.
